Graduated in History from the Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile and from the Andrés Bello Diplomatic Academy. Fluent in Spanish, English and French.

His first twenty years of his diplomatic career were spent in the bilateral area, working as Secretary and Consul of the Chilean Embassies in Lebanon, Egypt, Thailand, France and Morocco.

In 2001, he began his work in the multilateral area. He was called to join the Permanent Mission of Chile to the United Nations, due to his knowledge of the conflict in the Middle East and Western Sahara. In this assignment, he was part of the Chilean team before the Security Council and assumed the position of Vice-Chairman of the Fourth Committee of the United Nations General Assembly (2002).

Subsequently, he served as Special Assistant to the UN Secretary General's Envoy for Haiti (Minustah - 2004/2005).

Later, he assumed as Alternate Representative of Chile to UNESCO (2005/2010); Alternate Representative of Chile to the United Nations and O.O.II, in Geneva (2011/2016); and Ambassador of Chile to Ireland (2016/ 2019).

During his stays in Chile, he has held the positions of Chief of the Ceremonial Department (1990/1991); Head of the Sea Department (1997/1998); Head of the United Nations Department (2004/2005); Deputy Director of the Diplomatic Academy "Andrés Bello" (2010/2011); and currently as Director of Multilateral Policy of the Foreign Ministry.
