Rodrigo Donoso (Temuco, Chile 30/03/1963) is a graduate from the Diplomatic Academy of Chile and holds a Master's degree in International Studies from the University of Chile. He has a degree in English by the Universidad de la Frontera-Chile. He completed postgraduate studies in International Relations at the University of Paris XI, namely a DESS «*Diplomatie et Administration des Organisations internationales*» (1992-1993) University of Paris XI; a Degree by the Institut International d'Administration Publique-ENA, Paris (1992-1993); and a master Lehrgang für internationale Studien (1995-1996), by the University of Vienna.

Rodrigo Donoso was Director General for Consular Affairs, Immigration and Chileans Abroad at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (2022-2024), Ambassador of Chile in Haiti (2019-2022), DCM at the Mission of Chile to the EU and Embassy of Chile to Belgium and Luxembourg (2018-2019); DCM at the Mission of Chile to the WTO (2010-2013); Senior Delegate at the Mission of Chile to the United Nations in Geneva (2008-2010); Delegate at the Mission of Chile to the United Nations in New York (2000-2005) and Delegate in the Mission of Chile to the United Nations in Vienna(1994-1999). He was Secretary at the Embassy of Chile in Austria and Consul of Chile in Vienna. In the summer of 2011 Ambassador Donoso served as Chargé of Affairs at the Embassy of Chile in Croatia.

At the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Santiago, Ambassador Donoso worked as Joint Chief of Staff of the Minister for Foreign Affairs; Chief of Staff of the Director General for International Economic Relations; Joint Chief of Staff of the Secretary General for Foreign Policy; at the Directorate of International and Human Security; the Directorate General of Ceremonial and Protocol; and the Directorate of Cultural Affairs. Mr. Donoso was also liaison-officer of MOFA Chile with ABAC¹.
