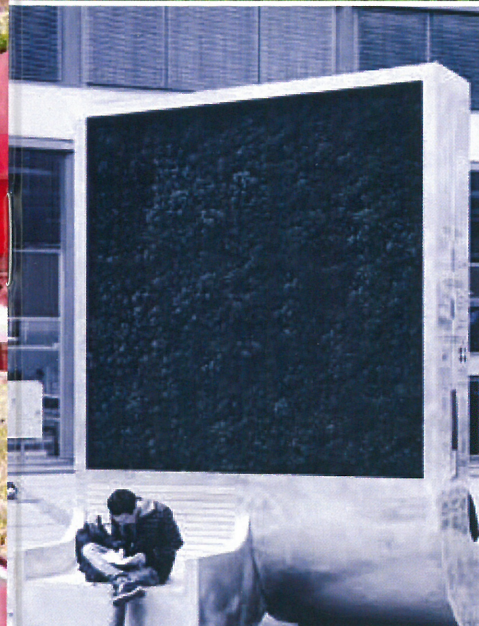

What is EIT Climate-KIC?

The need for climate innovation
