

# Chinese Language program in Taiwan

## “Huayu Enrichment Scholarship”

The Ministry of Education of the Republic of China (Taiwan) offers scholarships for a **total of 60 months**, divided into **scholarships for the period of 6 and 3 months** to citizens of Austria, Slovenia and Croatia in the academic year 2022/23 for the study of Mandarin Chinese.

### Value of the Scholarship:

Monthly grant: 25.000 New Taiwan Dollars (about 798 Euros, exchange rate of Jan. 10<sup>th</sup>, 2022 1€=31,30 NTD).

Attention: fees like travel expenses, tuition fees and health insurance, etc. are **not** paid additionally

### Scholarship period:

Scholarship for six months: September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022 through February 28<sup>th</sup>, 2023; or March 1<sup>st</sup> through Aug. 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023

Scholarship for three months: one trimester in the academic year 2022/23 (Sept.-Nov.; Dec.-Feb.; March-May; June-Aug.)

### Requirements for qualification:

- Austrian, Croatian or Slovenian citizenship
- Students are **not eligible** to apply if they:
  - have already received a Taiwan or Huayu Enrichment Scholarship in the past
  - are currently enrolled in a language or degree program in Taiwan
  - will be part of a student's exchange-program in the academic year 2022/23
  - possess R.O.C. passport or are overseas Chinese students

- Photocopy of the completed application form for a Chinese language centre in Taiwan (see homepages of Chinese language centres or [www.studyintaiwan.org](http://www.studyintaiwan.org))
- Two letters of recommendation
- Study plan written in English or Chinese
- TOCFL (Test of Chinese as a foreign language) participation confirmation (not mandatory)

**Applicants who have participated in TOCFL receive priority in award of scholarships; next TOCFL on April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022 in Vienna and April 9<sup>th</sup> 2022 in Ljubljana**

### Application deadline: April 29<sup>th</sup>, 2022

#### Review & Selection:

After successful submission of application materials, applicants have to do an interview between **10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> of May 2022** (via webcam) with the Education Division in Austria. The list of candidates will be published on **May 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022**. Candidates are required to submit their admission letters issued by the university together with the originally signed “**Huayu Enrichment Scholarship Terms of Agreement**” to the Education Division in Vienna by **June 20<sup>th</sup>, 2022**
